Coastal Mexican fish tacos are the magnetic buzz at this small counter-service Dillon shopping plaza eatery. Summit County regulars flock to the locally owned scratch kitchen for the hand-breaded, lightly fried Baja fish tacos (\$11 for a hefty order of three). Top them however you like—we recommend the Chimayo chipotle pepper sauce—and dance out the door happily full and ready for the night. *324 Dillon Ridge Road*
